

Bird Nest Supply Shop

HOW TO MAKE THIS:



1 Put the nesting materials in shallow bowls. You can skip this step if you choose to leave the materials in piles instead.

2 Place the nesting materials outside in a spot that's easy for birds to see. You'll want to make sure it's sheltered from the wind so the nesting materials won't blow away.

3 Keep an eye on the nesting materials from a distance to see which birds stop by, and see if you can spot any new nests in your backyard!

What you need:

- An adult to help
- Nest-building materials (see list below)
- A shallow bowl or open container for each material (optional)

Nest Building Supplies

- Dry twigs
- Dry leaves
- Dry grass
- Feathers
- Cattail fluff
- Cotton
- Moss
- Bark strips
- Pine needles
- Pet hair that hasn't had flea or tick treatments
- Wood chips
- Mud
- Straw or hay
